2. Budget. Director Harvey met with Roseville's Assistant Controller, Jane, to go over the library's budget. The budget they developed together has been presented to the City Council and needs to be approved. The budget projects \$909,000 for the library from the mil for the 2012-13 budget year. The library is currently budgeted for 94.5 p/t hours and, if approved, the new budget would add 43.5 p/t hours, which would be broken down as follows: 20 hours for a new p/t librarian; an extra day for Paul Konkolesky and Jason Novetsky; extra hours for Pat Eick; extra hours for subs; and 12 hours for clerical.
3. Erin Auditorium and Library Conference Room. Director Harvey will continue to deny use of the rooms to groups outside of the city due to security concerns and library hours.
