

ROSEVILLE PUBLIC LIBRARY MISSION STATEMENT

The Roseville Public Library is to serve as the cultural and informational center for the City of Roseville in order to provide a wide variety of materials, programs and services for residents of all ages.

The Library's principal responsibility shall be the provision of resources: to meet the informational needs of individuals, organizations, and businesses; to facilitate informal self-educational study; and to provide recreational materials.

The Library recognizes that informational, cultural and recreational sources encompass a broad range of materials including print, non-print and electronic media and that the scope of library services includes materials and programs for adults, young adults, and children.

The Library is also to be a resource where individuals are free to learn about controversial issues, to consider them from all sides, and to arrive at their own decisions. The Roseville Public Library therefore supports the principles of intellectual freedom as set forth by the [Freedom to Read Statement](#) by the American Library Association and in the [Library Bill of Rights](#).
