

## Committees

Much of the Society's work is accomplished through committees. Members are needed, and encouraged, to participate in the committees and/or projects of their choice.

Archives – Assisting in indexing historical materials as needed. Obtaining historical memorabilia such as photos, clippings, programs, etc.

Publications – Producing and mailing the Newsletter. Publishing and distributing historical post cards, etc.

Historian – Adding clippings and photographs of RHGS activities to the Historian book.

Membership – Keeping a current list of the memberships and mailing membership cards.

Oral History – Interviewing and recording local citizen interviews.

Nominations – Serving on the committee for the annual meeting election.

Historic House Markers – Providing materials and mailings to prospective eligible residents of historic homes.

The RHGS is a member of the Michigan Genealogical Council and the Federation of Genealogical Societies.

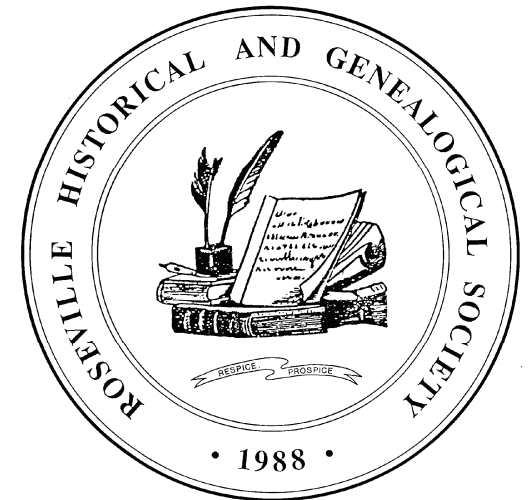
